## **DECISION**

### **SPECIFYING CRITERIA FOR GRANTING DEROGATIONS FROM REQUIREMENTS FOR CONNECTION OF NEW AND EXISTING HIGH VOLTAGE DIRECT CURRENT SYSTEMS AND DIRECT CURRENT-CONNECTED POWER PARK MODULES**

#### **I**

This Decision specifies the Criteria for granting derogations from requirements for connection of new and existing high voltage direct current systems (HVDC systems) and direct current-connected power park modules (PPMs) to the transmission network and the distribution network of the Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

#### **II**

The Criteria referred to in Point I of this Decision shall be published on the official website of the State Electricity Regulatory Commission (SERC).

#### **III**

SERC shall notify the Energy Community Secretariat of the determination of criteria and their content.

#### **IV**

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption and it shall be published in the Official Gazette of Bosnia and Herzegovina, official gazettes of the Entities and the Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina as well as on the official SERC website.
